

# Town of Fountain Hills Proclamation

## Termination of Proclamation of Emergency (9)

**WHEREAS**, on March 11, 2020, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, determined that the COVID-19 outbreak presents conditions in Arizona that justified his declaration of a State of Emergency based upon the outbreak's threat to human health and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 18, 2020, the Mayor of the Town of Fountain Hills, Ginny Dickey authorized by Town Code § 3-5-4(B), A.R.S. § 26-307, and/or A.R.S. § 26-311 proclaimed that a local emergency exists and, thereafter, imposed all necessary regulations to preserve the peace and order of the Town; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 30, 2022, the Governor of the State of Arizona, Douglas A. Ducey, issued proclamation "Termination of Emergency, COVID-19"; ending the state's COVID-19 Declaration of Emergency based on the state reaching thresholds established by the Arizona Department of Health Services that established the virus as no longer being widespread as it once was; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 30, 2022, the Chairman of the Maricopa County Board of Supervisors, ended their COVID-19 Emergency Declaration; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Town Code § 3-5-4(B), A.R.S. § 26-307, and/or A.R.S. § 26-311, the Mayor is authorized to declare termination of Proclamation of Emergency (9)

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I Ginny Dickey, Mayor of the Town of Fountain Hills, do hereby proclaim termination of the Town's Emergency Proclamation (9).
