## RESOURCES FOR ASSISTANCE

As a means of better serving the Seniors of Fountain Hills, the following is a listing of some organizations who provide assistance. Contact these organizations directly for additional information. Please note that this is NOT a comprehensive listing. These resources are not “approved” or “certified” by the Community Center. Most of the providers herein listed have come to the Center to offer their services or are listed in the phone book.

1. **Home Delivered Meals** – 480-816-5200.
2. **Crisis Response: 602-222-9444.** Call them if you need a team to help someone in FH. They will contact the client to see if the client wants their help.
3. **St. Vincent de Paul** – 480-837-7287 – Catholic Church of the Ascension. Food boxes, occasional utility/rent assistance/other. Leave message to call as phone messages are checked daily.
4. **Extended Hands Food Bank** – 480-837-0303. Pastor David Iverson. Food boxes. Call for hours open.
5. **Mayo Clinic** – 480-301-5990- Jill. Free wigs and other products. Also, transportation for cancer patients only. Person does not have to be receiving care from the Mayo Clinic to qualify. Must be receiving some form of treatment....prescription medication, etcetera.
6. **SRP - Salvation Army** – 480-837-0303. David Iverson – may pay overdue bills only. Call for details.
7. **Gas for Car-Salvation Army** – 480-837-0303. David Iverson. \$25 gasoline gift cards. Call for details.
8. **SRP** – 602-236-8888-“Empower” program for low income households.
9. **Fountain Hills School District Administration Office** – 480-664-5000. May give free meals to kids that need meals and parents can’t afford them.
10. **Area Agency on Aging** – 602-264-4357. May assist families that are on Medicaid/disability of a family member, regardless of age.
11. **R.U.O.K.** – Daily automated calls by the Sheriff’s Office to see if you’re okay. Call or stop by the Senior Activity Center for full information. 480-816-5200.

30. **Memory Café** – Meets in-person at the Community Center on the second Thursday of the month at 9:30 a.m. with coffee and pastries. Support group and activity group activities are 10-11 a.m. For questions, call 480-816-5200. The Café provides a social and resource space for people living with memory loss and their care partners. Caregivers participate in an educational and/or support session while those with memory loss actively participate in a cognitive engagement program.
31. **Medication Disposal:** Town Hall-inside by Sheriff's Office-Mon-Thurs, 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.
32. **Unique Lab Services:** Blood draw in your home. 480-765-2677
33. **Arizona Adult Protective Services (APS) - 1-877-767-2385. (or) 602-542-1025)** To report the neglect, abuse, or exploitation of vulnerable adult. (self-neglect is where the safety or well-being is being compromised by a person's inability to take care of their basic needs, their medical needs, their finances, their home environment or their personal hygiene). Hours open to report abuse, neglect, and exploitation of Arizona's vulnerable or incapacitated adults: Monday-Friday, 8 a.m.-5 p.m.
34. **A Caregiver** (even a non-relative) may qualify for getting paid for their care giving services. Call Altecs at 602-417-6600 to apply.
